Time Commitment: Workshop on January 7-8, 2026, in Miami, FL (paid); 5 hrs/week starting in January 2026 for 3 months virtually or at Cleveland State University (unpaid)

Student Responsibilities: We are looking for a motivated entrepreneurial student to join our team for the VentureWell E-Team Program. We are developing a fabric-based sweat potassium sensor that can measure sweat potassium levels in real time while focusing on women's health and menopause. The responsibilities of this student will include market research on wearable health technologies and women's health markets, customer discovery, business model development, and preparing presentations and pitching materials for workshops. The student will aid in scheduling, interviewing, and documenting insights from athletes, clinicians, and active women in menopause. This opportunity will allow the student to gain hands-on experience in early-stage commercialization while working with a multidisciplinary team in biomedical engineering and entrepreneurship.


