2021 marks the 100th year in which the first Black CPA John W. Cromwell was licensed. Despite significant focus and financial investment over the past 50 years the number of Black CPAs is still less than 1%.

The National Society of Black Certified Public Accountants, Inc. a nonprofit (501 c3) organization of licensed CPAs has developed a CPA exam review program - CPA Breakthrough to increase these disappointing numbers.
